Dr. Paul Yip



The CSCC is pleased to recognize the contributions and commitment of Paul Yip, PhD, FCACB to education and learning by honoring him with the 2018 CSCC Award for Education Excellence.

Over the years, Dr. Yip has made significant contributions to the education of undergraduate students, medical students, residents, post-doctoral fellows and clinical chemistry colleagues. Dr. Yip has been course coordinator and instructor for the course Introduction of the Biochemistry of Human Disease in the Faculty of Arts and Science since 2007. He has contributed to the undergraduate medicine program (all years) and created and sponsored the Clerkship elective in Clinical Biochemistry since 2009. Dr. Yip has also been the site supervisor for clinical chemistry post-doctoral

trainees at the University of Toronto (over 30 trainees since 2006) and also supervised General Pathology residents during their biochemistry rotation (2009-2013). Paul was recently recognized with the 2017 Undergraduate Teaching Award in Life Sciences for the Faculty of Medicine at the University of Toronto.

Dr. Yip has also made many significant educational contributions to the CSCC and CACB. Dr. Yip was the co-Chair of the CSCC Education Roundtables for ten years (2007-17). This was a large undertaking for the CSCC membership that, over this decade, grew to involve 200+ individuals and 50+ sites each week. He has contributed to annual meeting planning committees and served on the organizing committee for the 2017 joint annual meeting of CSCC and AACC in San Diego. In addition, Dr. Yip served on the CACB Board of Directors as the leader of the Professional Development Program, overseeing the review of educational activities undertaken by CACB fellows to assure maintenance of competency. He also contributed to the CACB certification exam committee (2010-2013) and the CACB exam preparation course (2015 & 16).

Dr. Yip has also contributed to the Institute for Quality Management in Healthcare (IQMH), working on the organizing committee for several educational workshops and conferences (2012-2016).
